BOVEYS DOWN FARM SITE RULES & INFORMATION

Rules and red tape are never popular but unfortunately some thoughtless, irresponsible people make their introduction necessary so please take a few moments to read the following.

Arrival/Departure

- Caravans/motorhomes must be parked on left side of farm track; tents must be pitched on right side of farm track (as you enter farm gate)
- Pitches are available from noon on the day of your arrival.
- All respective pitches should be vacated by 12 noon of your specified departure date.
- For all patrons' safety please pitch at least 3 metres away from other campers.
- The speed limit on-site is 5 mph and we ask all drivers to be aware of the possible presence of young children and/or farm animals.

Facilities

- Clothes lines are not permitted anywhere on site due to space limitations, site aesthetics and potential hazardousness at night (clothes horses and window racks welcomed)
- Tow-on/off available (if needed)
- Washing up facilities are situated by the toilet block; there is a fresh water tap as well as a fridge and microwave for campers' usage at the main farm building
- Generators are not permitted on site; electric hook-up available.
- Designated recycling/refuse point is located by the site entrance.
- Charcoal, logs, firelighters, perishables and other foodstuffs available on site.
- When Reception is closed an emergency contact number for the Site Manager will be displayed on the door

Fires/bbqs

- Fires are **only** permitted in the designated area (ask for details) and are chargeable unless you have brought your own fire-pit.
- Fires are not permitted in the woodland regardless of woodland pitch booking.
- Barbecues may be lit provided they are raised off the ground and are in a suitable container.
 Please ensure the smoke and fumes do not annoy other site users. In times of very dry weather, when the fire risk is high, the use of barbecues may be restricted.

Dogs

- DOGS MUST BE KEPT ON A LEAD (not exceeding 10ft) AND KEPT UNDER CONTROL AT ALL TIMES WHILST ON SITE.
- Dog owners are responsible for the removal of any waste your animal may produce whilst on site (Dog faeces contain diseases such as Toxocariasis, a parasitic infection that most commonly affects children, and may cause stomach pains, fever and even blindness.)

- Please be advised your usage of the site is confined to what is stated on your booking sheet, additional tents/adults/add-ons etc. without the owners' consent or knowledge is strictly prohibited. Violation may lead to additional charges, and/or possible eviction.
- WHILST ON SITE ALL PATRONS, AND THEIR GUESTS, ARE EXPECTED TO CONDUCT THEMSELVES
 ACCORDINGLY AND RESPECT OTHER CAMPERS AND THEIR PRIVACY. ABUSE, DISRUPTION
 AND/OR VIOLENCE WILL NOT BE TOLERATED IN ANY WAY AND WE RESERVE THE RIGHT TO
 IMMEDIATELY EVICT ANY SUCH PERSON(S) VIOLATING THESE RULES!
- To respect the enjoyment of others, we ask that noise levels are kept to a minimum after 11pm.
